Rhapsody Wi-Fi What's This All About ?



Welcome to our Rhapsody Music and Wi-fi radio service.

This leaflet will guide you on our music & Wi-fi service, how to get connected and what you can expect from rhapsody.

The League of friends radio station Radio Heatherwood can be heard through this service along with Radio 2 and Radio Berkshire. In addition those connected will have access to internet and email.

What Can I Expect To Hear On The Radio Station ?

Radio Heatherwood plays music from the 1950's right up to the present day as well as comedy three times a day, and spoken word including poetry and short stories. We also play the classics.

At 11pm and 1am most nights, we have our meditation sessions for those having trouble relaxing.

During our live sessions we play patients choice of requests and dedications as well as bringing you local news and information.

In addition we take requests from members of the hospital staff.

How Do I Listen ?

If you have a smart phone ipad net-book/laptop or you are close to a ward radio, you will be able to tune in.

Where Can I Find Help On Registering on the Rhapsody Wi-fi?

There are posters on the wards, plus a special logging on leaflet which can be found on the ward. Our radio staff will also help when we come to collect your requests.

This booklet also carries details for registering the popular devices.

The League of friends of Heatherwood hospital are providing the Wi-Fi service to support the delivery of the radio service and provide contact for patients and staff with their loved ones.

The access to the internet is limited and certain web sites will not be accessible, as the content is being limited to prevent unsuitable material being displayed.

Norton DNS servers with a policy of 3 (Non-family friendly websites) is in use and for further information about availability this can be found at http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Norton_DNS

Sites where videos or music can be downloaded will also have limited availability. File sharing and

downloads will also be limited.

The limiting of video and file downloading is to ensure access for all users, without slowing the broadband service.

They must be returned to the ward staff, upon your departure.

Please note each radio has a unique number, all are registered to the League of friends, once connected to the internet they can be tracked.

Please do not remove them from the ward.

Can I Use My Own Internet Radio To Listen to Radio Heatherwood ?

No :- The radio would need registering to the hotspot server.

All radio's have to be registered.

I-phones/I-Pads Rhapsody Registration.



How To Tune Into Radio Heatherwood, It's Easy !



There are many different versions of I-phones/I-pads and all will have a slightly different way to set-up connections to Wi-fi signals.

On this page we will show you the basics for an I-phone/I-pad, be aware depending on which version of software you have will determine the screen you display.



On your device go to settings and

"select Wi-fi."



If turned on you will see a list of available networks.

"Turn on" if turned off, after a few seconds rhapsody should show on the display.

Choose **"rhapsody"** enter password **"rhapsody"** without the quotes and lowercase.

After a few seconds you should

be connected to rhapsody.

Open your internet browser and enter **"radio"** in your browser search.

This will then take you to our log on web page and terms conditions screen .

"click Connect & Agree"

You will then see the default home page for our Wi-fi radio service.



"Select Radio Heatherwood picture or menu item."



Scroll down page and

Press **"Play"** on player

After a few seconds you will be listening to our live feed.

Two other radio services are also available from our Wi-fi service.

Loan Internet Radio's

Using The Loan Radio Service

Available to the ward are a number of internet loan radio's.



These radio's are registered to the rhapsody Wi-fi service. The radio's have been provided with three presets which are programmed to deliver Radio Heatherwood Radio Two or Radio Berkshire.



If you wish to listen to the hospital radio service this radio is programmed to allow access.



connects.

The radio will lock onto the last station the radio was tuned to.

If you wish to change channels



"Press" the power switch and wait whilst it

"Press" the preset button and **"rotate"** the control until the desired station then

"Press" the rotary control.



The rotary control will also adjust your volume by rotating.

Last Listened

It is also possible to choose your last listened to radio station by **"Pressing"** the menu button and with the last listened highlighted in the display **"Press"** the rotary control.

By **rotating** the control a number of stations will be shown, to make a selection, just highlight and **"Press"** the rotary control on your choice.


