If you wish to do something else, horoscopes etc, etc; discuss this with the manager, and lets have a reduction on the quiz front.

I would remind everybody, that the patient has the right to choose the time not the presenter. If the slot is genuinely full up explain that you are full in that time, and offer the next available time. Don't tell patients that you can't have it, and don't give an explanation .
