(25:2)After each broadcast has taken place and the staff are ready to depart from the studio the team leader will ensure the following has been carried out:-







The song goes" can you please please help me " or in our case " us " We need to raise £6506.08 this is the expected cost to implement all of the changes which will be required.







As with other areas of our operation this year our sponsors of loan radios has been low. This year has only seen a total of three. We need to obtain new sponsors all the time so as to put out new units to replace units which become beyond repair or are stolen from the wards. An overall total of 152 units on the wards is not what we would expect to find as we know some have disappeared. Please make an effort in your programs to ensure promotion of the sponsorship program.

Maintenance Man

The overall maintenance of the loan radio service has now been taken over by yours truly. Some new modifications to the loan radio units are being monitored to see if they cut down the amount of faults on units.

It is important when on ward round to see that any faulty units are recovered as soon as possible. In the graph shown an indication of who is removing the faulty units. A team effort is required. All nights should be removing them.

It would appear at present we are

removing up to six units most weeks.

🕮 Battery Sales

At the time of writing (16/10) this week has seen a dramatic rise to double our normal weekly total in sales. Whilst this is good news, a complaint received this week by the management from the nursing staff indicates a problem we are not addressing in the weekday.

Note for Team leaders

If you have a full complement of staff on your night and a request has been made to the radio station for batteries from a ward you would not reach for requests: Please ensure a member of your nights staff make a visit to the ward just to sell batteries.



3 Engineering Corner








A faulty unit left on the ward helps no one?

Loan Radio Faulty Units Removed from Wards By Night 1st April 1994 till 31st March 1995 77 units Removed


