Serious Fault Today

I arrived today to find a serious fault with what I thought was a problem on the mixer in studio two. The mixer was picking up the radio 2 service without any faders up. It was quite loud and would have meant not being able to use the studio.

After removing all the leads in studio one and two and turning of the 100volt bedhead amps and spending 45 mins on this, we pinpointed a problem with a signal fed to the reception selection panel. It turns out, someone had pushed the button in for studio 2 as well as the button for TX this provided a path for the signal to return to studio two from the output of TX.

This panel should only allow the sources to be selected one at a time however it seems the locking pins on the selector buttons must be damaged.

Please Please take care when using this panel, make sure the button you select releases the other sources or you may find your colleague in one of the studio's will have a music source he/she was not expecting.

The only other button to be depressed at the same time as one of the music sources is the mute button.
