Some news about our meeting tonight

We were asked to attend a meeting with the director of services to hear about the patient power project.

The outcome in brief terms was an agreement to work more closely together on the introduction of the patient power terminals and to liaise over the messages which would be transmitted during our 24 hour service. A demo of the software will given to members of the hospital next week.

The requests we have made to the hospital are

- 1) Connection to the system
- 2) Can we have a terminal in the studio for training and contact from the
- 3) What will be displayed on the terminal screen when patients listen to Radio heatherwood? Will we have the opportunity to determine that picture.
- 4) Will patients have access to ring the studio?

The news from them on the progress, is they hope to have some terminals up and running by Christmas. To be complete by April next year. They said that they are not going to turn it on until all the wards have been fitted

They intend to have staff on site all the time.
