

Ascot Fire Brigade Trust

The good news that was confirmed this week was the confirmation of the balance of the funding for Rhapsody. They have pledged £4000. (Look at the web site news page)

Rhapsody Progress

The next stage of the project for us, is to purchase the computers along with the software and install. In addition to this we need to load the music database and edit and correct errors. The purchase of the computers and software will require a sum of at least £6200. It is hoped that these can be purchased before Christmas, as this will allow extra time which I have between Christmas and the new year to spend on the computer side. (I am currently waiting for the final quotes on the computers).

The next stage in the new year will be to purchase the balance of the interface equipment which will be required and then fitted into the studio during January/February 2003. This would require the balance of the grants. After this has been completed, training of staff will commence on the system plus the recording of items. A test for the service will commence Saturday 5th April 2003.

The final stage will be launching the service fully on 7th June 2003 three days before the 27th birthday of the radio service. On this day, all those involved will be invited along for the official launch along with local press etc.

Matthew will be meeting with us next Saturday and we will try and put more detail together. The Above paragraph's were my response to the sponsors.
