I attended meeting Friday last with the coordinator from the trust. Some good news from the meeting but also some concerns. Heatherwood has completed all it's wiring and work has progressed to the second stage with the fixing of the wall brackets in the Maternity unit. Maternity is the first unit to go live. Unfortunately the hospital have decided that the radio station does not need to be connected from the start, and so isn't. The orthopaedic wards will be next after the maternity. A number of issues raised at this meeting means a further one needs to be arranged.

New Playlist

The new playlist comes into use from today and you will see there is a change to the program structure slightly to match Rhapsody. When filling it out, remember all items from the computer have a number and this should be entered in the appropriate boxes. CD no's should be the first six characters i.e. cd0001(06). The last two digits are the track number (Not Required).

Where we have marked patient information as Mandatory you should play one item as well as one item from one of the other grey categories in that break.

Additions

This week I have added some new mixes to the comedy trailers you made earlier. These carry short clips from the comedy shows which will be transmitted. they can be found in the program trailers category and are numbered Jcom9000-9006. They are all very similar apart from the fact the position of your insert changes on each one.

Station Output

Last week nobody spotted that the output was very low and was poor. This would have been reflected in low signal on the fader for Rhapsody as well as the listening radio in reception. Do take time to monitor the signal via the radio during the evenings so that if there is a problem you will spot it.

Water Bottles

Under the tea bar there is 4 large water bottles which were left over from yesterday's launch. Don't throw them away, as we can use them to get more supplies from ward 10.

New Program Schedules
