Some important info for you.

Studio Heating

There is no studio heating. I have been in contact with the works dept today and it's going to be like this for at least another two weeks. A burst pipe in the underground services has meant our building has been switched off.

I would suggest you wear warm clothing to the studio. I have turned off the cooling unit in engineering so that any heat generated will raise the engineering library etc a little.

Wavecart Problems

As I have been conducting program training and broadcasting these last couple of weeks I have noticed some problems in the operation on both machines.

What you may have noticed having created a stack is when you load another song into that stack later on, that a deck with another item will turn grey and lose its timing and play buttons.

Another bug that manifests itself is while scanning down the audio files it may lock onto one music file in black then when you try to fire off one of the decks it won't respond. The program then becomes unstable and freezes. The only cure at this stage is close down wavecart and re-start. Not very helpful if you are in a program.

The bugs which are there are not being helped by individuals creating file names for stacks which exceed the 8.3 rule. I have today for the second week running deleted three stacks with names incompatible with the program. Please please follow the rule.

I have made some changes today to the operation of the two computers. Screen colours have been reduced and mouse trails have been removed from the screens to help cut down on processing power being wasted. You will notice when you look at the folders for audio files this has now changed to the light green for karts and light yellow for the files.

I visited the discussion group for wavecart and this bug has been experienced by other stations and what seems to trigger this off is the right clicking on an audio file in the list and then clicking on play (to listen on the blue speakers). The only way other stations have got around this problem is to stop their staff from using the facility.

In the light of the info now available I have decided to remove the audition feature from the studio machines. The small speakers will be removed.

One final note to all, if you have finished with old stacks delete them when you come in the following week.

And finally
