

Reception

When TX is selected on the buttons for listening. The sound you hear is what the patients are hearing. No sound or poor quality sound means problems for the patients.

I would recommend you have this button selected at all times throughout the evening then at least you will notice a problem.

Reception Radio

Switch it on can you hear our signal?.

A problem with no signal on here would mean all ward staff radio's would not be able to listen to the service.

On the Wards

Tune the first patient in and listen on their terminal before you collect all the requests. Good strong loud signal needs to be heard.

Engineering

Team leaders are you checking the TX as instructed?
